Monitoring and metrics are important to every organization, but how do you decide what to monitor? Too much data can become overwhelming and less useful even than too little data. In this talk we will cover Etsy's journey towards effective metrics and monitoring, discussing not only the technologies used but also the business considerations and impact. We will follow the history of Etsy's monitoring from the beginning into a deep dive of everything we

use to measure and graph today. The audience will leave with an understanding of the decisions we made along the way, and have the ability to apply the lessons we learned as we continue to scale our company and our monitoring operations to their organization.

Katherine is an operations engineer at Etsy. She got her start in programming with TI-80 calculators back when Geocities was still cool, and these days has opinions on things like ‘the cloud’ and ‘devops’. Before escaping to the world of operations, she spent a few years doing QA and systems engineering in the corporate world.
