## Details

It seems obvious that inline documentation would be inherently superior to separately-maintained documentation, but making things happen isn't always so simple.

We'll examine many dev-time and ops-time documentation techniques to maintain cadence without incurring technical debt:

- Commenting in source, in configuration, and in the operational environment itself
- Native tools for a number of popular languages
- Build-time generation of documentation
- Coverage of the latest formats, techniques, and tools
- Specific recommendations applicable to a variety of devops environments
- When and what you shouldn't document
- The reasons why documentation doesn't happen and approaches for remediation.
